DIRECTIONS

Directions From Cleveland:

- Take 90 east from Cleveland. Be sure to stay on Rt. 90 through the 90/2 and 90/271 splits). Follow 90 east past Erie, PA.
- Take Route 86 east (Follow Jamestown signs). Continue on 86 as you cross over Lake Chautauqua.
- Exit at the Exit 21/Route 219 Salamanca exit. This is the **SECOND** Salamanca exit. If driving at night, be careful not to pass up the exit, as it comes up suddenly after rounding a turn in the road.
- Turn left at the stop sign at the bottom of the exit ramp. Go approx. ½ mile
- Turn right at the next stop sign. Pass under first train bridge. Go approx. ½ mile
- Turn left on Route 219 and head north (Uni-Mart station on the corner). Go approximately 3 miles.
- Turn left at Porter Hollow Road/Klawitter Road. (If you go under a second train bridge, you've gone too far.)
- At the next stop sign, take the road with the "dead end" sign (Porter Hollow Rd.)
- The driveway to Alden's Acres is approximately 1 mile on the right hand side. Look for the sign at the street.

From Holiday Valley/Ellicottville: Take Rt. 219 south. Upon entering Great Valley, you will come to a stop sign. At the four-way stop, take a right turn and continue south on 219. You'll pass under a train bridge, and Porter Hollow Rd. will be on your right hand side. The sign will say Porter Hollow/Klawitter Road. Turn right. At the top of the hill, take the center road. The sign will say Porter Hollow, but will be perpendicular to the street. Our house is the first house on the right – approx. one-half mile. There is an Alden's Acres sign in the front yard. Total distance to Holiday Valley is 6.5 miles.

PETS

All pets must be pre-approved prior to your arrival. Evidence of pets that were not pre-approved will result in loss of the security deposit. We have the right to refuse a pet on grounds of breed, size or for any other reason. No reason needs to be given for our refusal to accept a pet. If you have been given permission to bring your pet, please follow these rules to ensure that your additional deposit is returned.

- All pets must remain in the living room, dining room and kitchen – no pets are allowed in bedrooms under any circumstances
- All pets must be kenneled (one is available in the basement) or put in the basement when the owners leave the house.
- Please bring your pets food and water bowls; do not use our dishes
- Clean up after your pets after they use the yard. There may be plastic bags in the closet, but plan on bringing your own
- Do not allow pets on furniture
- In the event of an accident, there are cleaning supplies in laundry area or under sink. Please clean promptly.
- Do not leave your pets unattended while outdoors. There are leash laws in the township.
- Be sure to locate a local vet prior to coming here so that you are prepared in event of an emergency.
